ABOUT THIS DOCUMENT

This document explains the expectations the WTC has regarding player behavior. The document has information regarding the general sanction system that will be applied during the event, and stipulations regarding the interaction between players and/or our staff. Our Staff are all volunteering their time and effort to allow you to experience a great moment with your peers, so please already note that any kind of disrespect will not be tolerated and met with the harshest of consequences.

INTRODUCTION STATEMENT

At its core, the WTC tournament aims to bring together players from all over the world to compete in a friendly but competitive manner. We believe that everyone is entitled to be treated fairly regardless of gender, sexual orientation, age, disability, religion, color, race, ethnic or national origins, political ideology, or socio-economic background. Furthermore, we subscribe to the principles of equality of treatment and aim to ensure that anyone who attends is able to do so in a discrimination-free environment where everyone is treated with due respect. We are committed to ensuring that everyone is able to attend, free from direct discrimination or abuse (physical, verbal or otherwise). As such, we will not accept nor tolerate any actions that would result in an attendee receiving any less favorable treatment by any other attendees on the grounds of: gender, sexual orientation, age, disability, religion, color, race, ethnic or national origins, political ideology, or socio-economic background. We expect everyone to subscribe to, and do their best to uphold, these core principles by way of their attendance. We reserve the right to refuse entry to or expel from the venue, without refund, anyone who is deemed not to have acted to honor above standards.

GENERAL SANCTION SYSTEM

INTRODUCTION

Respect between individuals is one of the most important aspects of any event, and greatly so at the WTC. In this context, sanctions may be applied to ensure the smooth running of the event.

Our sanctioning system operates on 3 levels :

WARNING

Players receiving a given warning will be informed by the tournament organizer pertaining the reason(s) for it. A warning will always be privy to follow-up actions by the tournament leads to ensure that no recurrence of the behavior or the incident that sparked the warning takes place.

If, for whatever reason, you receive two warnings, you will immediately receive a yellow card; if you receive another warning, you will then receive a red card.

An example of some actions that will immediately result in a warning:

1. Treating any other players, tournament staff, or spectators disrespectfully.
2. Intentionally attempting to mislead your opponent or tournament staff.
3. Intentionally disrupting the placement of game components.
4. Removing dice from the table/dicetray before an opponent can verify the roll.
5. Deliberately skipping or failing to acknowledge phases or steps in the game in order to rush an opponent or cause them to miss their opportunity to trigger an ability.
6. Playing or setting up at an unreasonable pace in order to gain an advantage in the game.

YELLOW CARD

Players receiving a yellow card will be informed by the tournament organizer pertaining the reason(s) for it. A yellow card will always be privy to follow-up actions by the tournament leads to ensure that no recurrence of the behavior or the incident that sparked the yellow card takes place.

RED CARD

Players receiving a red card will be informed by the tournament organizer pertaining the reason(s) for it. A red card is a severe sanction and players subject to one will be immediately expelled from the event and be asked to leave the event hall immediately, without any rights for a refund. The player will be reported and flagged in BCP.

A committee will be convened to decide whether the player will be banned from events temporarily or permanently.

MULTIPLE SANCTIONS AGAINST THE SAME PLAYER

If a player is a repeat offender, sanctions may be applied across the different events hosted at WTC.

SANCTION SYSTEM BY EVENT

What follows below details the sanction system for both the WTC team and individual event for Killteam. Please read the sections carefully. If you are a Team Captain or representative for a given country, please make sure your team-members also read and understand the sanctions that might be imposed.

KILLZONE: MECHELEN SANCTION SYSTEM

OFFICIAL LANGUAGE FOR THE TOURNAMENT

The official language of the tournament, and the ONLY language that should be spoken at the gaming tables, is English. All players must be able to communicate in fluent English. Due to the international nature of our event this is non-negotiable.

Players, and non-players, that are caught not speaking English at a game table while addressing one of the players at that table, will be given an immediate yellow card infraction notice.

MISUSE OF THE RULES

In certain cases, the interplay between the rules may lead to misuse of the rules. We rely on the players to prevent this from happening by asking the right questions ahead of time. A section on the WTC Discord is available for requesting clarifications on the rules and their interactions. The referee team is available to answer all your questions. Note that every response from any member of the WTC team will be a final decision that must be respected by the players.

REPEATED MISINTERPRETATION OF RULES

A player caught to misplay in contradiction to an issued referee call will be given an immediate yellow card infraction notice. If the case is repeated, it will result in an immediate red card infraction notice.

PLAYER CONDUCT

Players attending the event are expected to always act in a sportsmanlike manner, and this not only towards their direct opponents. Disrespect towards a player, team staff, or WTC staff will be given an immediate yellow card infraction notice. If the case is repeated, it will result in an immediate red card infraction notice.

DISRESPECT

We will not accept nor tolerate any actions that would result in an attendee receiving any less favorable treatment by any other attendees on the grounds of: gender, sexual orientation, age, disability, religion, color, race, ethnic or national origins, political ideology, or socio-economic background. We expect everyone to subscribe to, and do their best to uphold, these core principles by way of their attendance. We reserve the right to refuse entry to or expel from the venue, without refund, anyone who is deemed not to have acted to honor above standards, and depending on the severity of the infraction, a warning, yellow card or red card will be issued by a WTC TO.

VIOLENT BEHAVIOR AND PHYSICAL ASSAULT

Any violent behavior, be it verbal or otherwise, will be met with an immediate Red card infraction notice by a WTC TO.

GAME PROGRESS

At the WTC we value playing by intent. You must always clearly communicate your intentions to your opponent and carefully measure and check lines of sight before moving your miniatures. To help you with this, it is highly recommended to bring a proxy miniature to perform physical actions and determine final positioning before moving the actual miniatures.

Once you state your intentions, your opponent must verbally agree, based on the rules, that an announced action is possible. In case of disagreement between players, the referees and/or TO are available to help facilitate resolving the gamestate.

Players that change the position of a mini, either by turning it or changing the location during their opponents turn/time or otherwise with the aim to obtain an advantage will be immediately awarded a warning, yellow card or red card infraction notice.

EVENT REGISTRATION & BCP INFORMATION

You must enter your faction in BCP within the deadlines indicated in the event pack. Players that fail to do so will be given an immediate Warning infraction notice prior to the start of the event.

PROXY MINIATURES & WYSIWYG

All proxies, or miniatures that don't meet WYSIWYG requirements, must be submitted in the appropriate section on the WTC Discord for approval by the Kill Team TO. A proxy is approved once the Kill Team TO replies in the given thread stating the proxy/conversion is approved. In cases where there was no prior approval, and the proxy creates confusion about the load out or the abilities of the original model at the event, the player fielding the model will receive an immediate Warning infraction notice.

WTC TEAM EVENT SANCTION SYSTEM

PROCESS

Whenever a situation arises with a team/player on a team that warrants a sanction, the TO will organize a meeting with the player and/or staff concerned and his captain to inform them about the infraction notice given and the consequences there-of.

WARNING

The warning is a notification of improper conduct or situation arising at the gaming table and serves as a reminder to a given team/player to act on that information for the continuation of the event. A warning will always be communicated to both the Captain and any other Team member involved and does not bear any other consequences for the current or past match.

YELLOW CARD

A player who receives a yellow card immediately loses the current or previous match with 0 points. His opponent will score the average points from the other games played by his team that round.

RED CARD

A player who receives a red card immediately loses the current or previous match with 0 points and will be asked to leave the event hall immediately. All subsequent matches played by the affected team will result in a loss with 0 points for the player in question. In cases where this happens, the opposing team will score the average of all their other games in that round for that match.

If more than one player is excluded from a team, the entire team will be excluded from the tournament. In cases where this happens, the opposing team will score the average of all other winning/drawing teams in that round.

INFORMATION

The WTC Team is available and will enforce active judging in order to prevent any sanctions, de-escalate tensions and ensure the best possible experience during the event. In all cases, you Killteam TO will take the final decision where necessary and debrief with the stakeholders for the decisions made.

A NOTE ABOUT CAPTAIN'S ROLE & TEAM STAFF

Captains and team staff are allowed to

Be the Non-Playing Team Captain

Do/assist the Pairings

Collate and submit Team Results

Ask questions about how the game is going (only in English)

Tell their player how their team is doing and what kind of points they require from this game

All other actions or communications (in English or in your own language) will be given an immediate yellow card infraction notice

PROXY MINIATURE

All proxies must be submitted in the appropriate section on the WTC Discord. In case it was not the case, WTC TO will be given an immediate Warning.
